v. Praise Him with timbrel and dance; praise Him with strings and pipe!


By be - ing bap - tized in the Jordan, O our Sav - ior, You sanctified

the wa - ters; by letting a ser - vant lay his hand on You,


You healed the pas - sions of the world. Great is the mystery of

Your div - ine plan. O loving Lord, glo - ry to You.






Though He is beyond all purity, Christ is bap - tized with us. He sanc -

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.


