



## Becoming a Fellowship Member

Since 1980, the Fellowship of Orthodox Stewards has been open to all members and friends of the Orthodox Church in America. Annual commitments to the Fellowship are voluntary. All Fellowship support directly benefits the outreach ministries of the Church. All commitments, whether one-time annual gifts, quarterly, or monthly gifts are gratefully accepted. The suggested commitment levels are:

Steward Benefactor	\$1000 +
Steward Principal	\$500 +
Steward Patron	\$250 +
Steward Donor	\$100 +

Any time during the year you may adjust your Fellowship commitments to reflect your personal circumstances.

A \$100 FOS commitment equals about 28 cents a day!

## Becoming a Parish FOS Member

In 1992 the 10th All-American Council established the "Parish FOS" membership program. Parishes that are willing and capable are encouraged to give above and beyond the individual FOS memberships in the parish to support the outreach work of the Church. The suggested Parish FOS membership levels are:

Level 1	\$1000 or 1% of parish income
Level 2	\$2500 or 2% of parish income
Level 3	\$5000 or 3% of parish income

The "Parish FOS" membership program helps parishes view their support for the outreach work of the Church in terms of freewill percentage giving.
