Strong Orthodox Christian presence at DC March for Life – despite the storm!

WASHINGTON, DC – Despite the threat of the worst snowstorm to hit the US capital in some 90 years, His Beatitude, Metropolitan Tikhon, clergy and seminarians, and faithful from across the country took part in the annual March

for Life here on Friday, January 22, 2016.

Metropolitan Tikhon was accompanied by His Eminence, Archbishop Melchisedek and His Eminence, Archbishop Michael. Also participating were His Eminence, Metropolitan Evangelos of the Greek Orthodox Metropolis of New Jersey and His Grace, Bishop John of the Antiochian Orthodox Christian Diocese of Worcester.

The March marked the 43rd anniversary of the Roe v. Wade decision that legalized abortion in the US.

During the pre-March rally, Metropolitan Tikhon was among the hierarchs on the stage as Metropolitan Evangelos offered the opening invo-

His Eminence, Archbishop Alejo of Mexico City, welcomed him and the members of the OCA delegation, which included Archpriests Eric G. Tosi and Antonio Perdomo and Archdeacon Joseph Matusiak.

The visit marked the 44th anniversary of the establishment of what is today the Diocese of Mexico.

Besides meeting with Archbishop Alejo and the diocese's clergy, Metropolitan Tikhon visited His Eminence, Metropolitan Antonio [Chedraoui] of the

Antiochian Orthodox Archdiocese of Mexico, Central America and Venezuela, and congratulated him on the 50th anniversary of his consecration to the episcopacy.

Recent meetings at OCA Chancery

SYOSSET, NY – Chancellors and Treasurers representing eight dioceses met with His Beatitude, Metropolitan Tikhon at the Chancery on January 19, 2016.

"I believe that this is one of the most important meetings of the year, since it allows for a parallel interaction to what takes place biannually in our Holy Synod meetings," Metropolitan Tikhon said. "It is very helpful for those who assist the bishops in their administrative work to share, learn, and strengthen the bond of unity between us."

A key issue considered during the meeting was the manner in which the dioceses are transitioning to the formula developed by the Finance Resolution adopted at the 18th All-American Council.

At the request of Metropolitan Tikhon, members of the Office of External Affairs and Interchurch Relations gathered for a consultation on January 21. His Grace, Bishop Alexander chaired the meeting, during which future plans and transitions were discussed. Broader issues related to *Continued on the reverse*
