5. I will walk in the presence of the Lord in the land of the living. *(Refrain)*
6. Glory... Now and ever... Amen. *(Refrain)*


Second Antiphon

Tone 2

O Son of God, seat - ed on the colt_ of an ass,
save us who sing to Thee: "Al - le - lu - ia!"

1. I kept my faith, even when I said, "I am greatly afflicted." *(Refrain)*
2. What shall I render to the Lord for all the things He has given me? *(Refrain)*
3. I will receive the cup of salvation, and call on the Name of the Lord. *(Refrain)*
4. I will pay my vows to the Lord in the presence of all His people. *(Refrain)*
5. Glory... *(Now and ever... Amen. Only-begotten Son...)*

The Antiphon verses can be straight chanted, or else intoned according to the following pattern:



I love the Lord _____ be - cause He has heard the voice of my sup - pli - ca - tion.

Be-cause He in-clined His ear _____ to me; there-fore I will call on Him as long as I live.

Third Antiphon verses (*Refrain* = Troparion of the feast)

1. O give thanks to the Lord, for He is good; for His mercy endures forever. (*Refrain*)
2. Let the house of Israel now say that He is good; for His mercy endures forever. (*Refrain*)
3. Let the house of Aaron say that He is good; for His mercy endures forever. (*Refrain*)
4. Let those who fear the Lord say that He is good; for His mercy endures forever. (*Refrain*)
