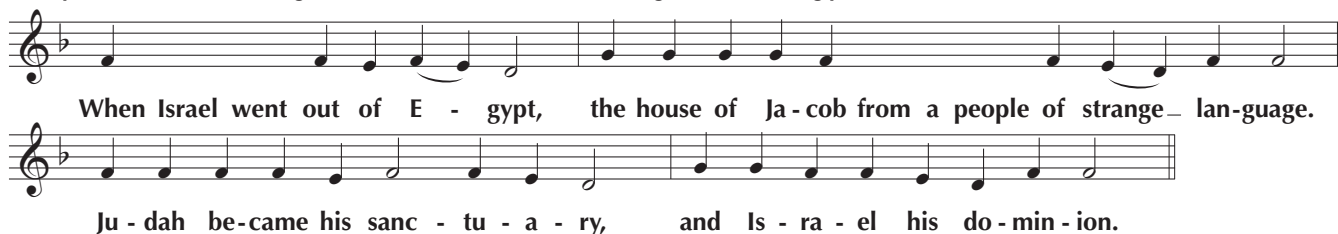


Sav-iour, save \_\_\_\_\_ us! save \_\_\_\_\_ us!
