Metropolitan Council concludes fall session, recommends St. Louis as site of 19th All-American Council

HUNTINGTON, NY-

The Metropolitan Council of the Orthodox Church in America held its fall session September 19-22, 2016.

The meeting was chaired by His Beatitude, Metropolitan Tikhon. Also present

were His Eminence, Archbishop Benjamin and His Eminence, Archbishop Michael of the Standing Synod of Bishops.

Among the items on the agenda was the venue for the 19th All-American Council [AAC], slated to convene July 23-28, 2018. Metropolitan Council members unanimously recommended Saint Louis, MO's Union Station Hotel as the AAC site. The recommendation will be referred to the Holy Synod of Bishops for approval at their October session. Council members further recommended that a youth program once again be held in conjunction with the national convention of the Fellowship of Orthodox Christians in America.

In his opening remarks, Metropolitan Tikhon expanded on his vision of the Church for the future, highlighting specific issues of particular interest to members of the Metropolitan Council. Reports and updates were offered by the Officers of the Church, the Office of External Affairs, the departments, the Pension Board, and the Stewards of the Orthodox Church in America [SOCA]. Council members unanimously passed the 2017 budget, which includes six planting grants for the coming year.

As in the case of the third volume, each question is keyed to the text's page numbers, while answers are provided in a separate document."
